**NOTICE OF CONTINUATION OF THE  
CALIFORNIA CITRUS NURSERY RESEARCH AND EDUCATION**

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES:

The California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) held a public hearing on July 14, 2015 in Visalia to consider the continuation of the California Citrus Nursery Research and Education Program (Program). Such a hearing is required every five years to provide citrus nurseries with the opportunity to comment on the usefulness and effectiveness of the Program's activities.

Based on the testimony and evidence in the hearing record, the Department found that there is not a substantial question regarding whether the Program should be continued. Therefore, the Department approved the continuation of the California Citrus Nursery Research and Education Program for five more years through December 31, 2020.
