



CAREER OPPORTUNITY: CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER

The [California Leafy Green Products Handler Marketing Agreement \(LGMA\)](#) represents the state's handlers of lettuce, spinach and other leafy green products, and is charged with certifying that its members only sell products that have been produced to accepted standards for food safety.

The LGMA is embarking on a search for a replacement Chief Executive Officer. The purpose of this role is to ensure LGMA operates in a way that protects public health while providing direction and leadership toward the achievement to the LGMA's mission, strategy and goals. The CEO will manage LGMA's activities and permanent staff, in keeping with the requirements of the California Department of Food and Agriculture's regulations and the Board's instructions.

Other Position Parameters

- The CEO reports to Chair of the LGMA Advisory Board.
- The CEO is supported by a team of 5 staff.
- The CEO is currently based in Sacramento, CA but the LGMA is open to an alternate location that would provide benefit to our membership (Monterey, Salinas, etc.).
- Regular domestic and occasional international travel required
- A comprehensive and competitive benefits and relocation package is included.

The search for a new CEO is starting now. The organization hopes to make a decision in October or November of 2020. Then in 2021 the new CEO can start learning about the organization and completely take over when the existing CEO, Scott Horsfall, retires in March of 2021.
